



Considered to be the AVID Student's "lifeline" that contains sections for class calendars, Cornell Notes, and learning logs.


The binders are specifically ordered to maximize student organization and learning in all classes.

### TUTORIALS


- Tutors facilitate student-to-student learning.
- Tutorials make up 40% of the class time.
- Students come to the elective class with two higher-level questions from their core classes.
- They present those questions to the group and through INQUIRY they work together to come to an answer.
- This COLLABORATION is the foundation of tutorials.
